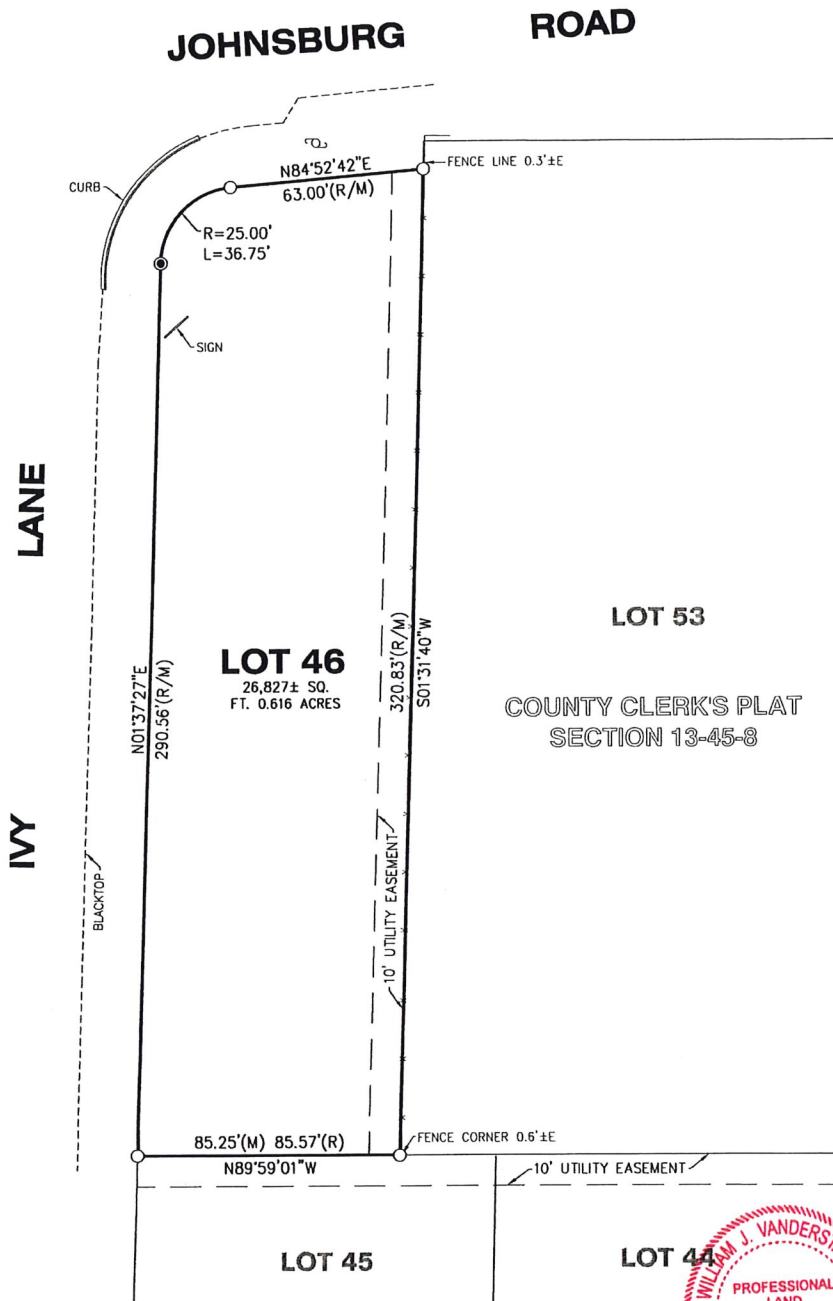




# PLAT OF SURVEY
