Permitted Activity: Removal of existing seawall, replacing with rip-rap shoreline revetment at 5226 Pine Lane Path


Work to be done under authority of this permit is subject to the following special restrictions, limitations & instructions.

X	1.	<u>PRIOR TO ANY EXCAVATION:</u> If not using existing drive, install a min. 10' wide x 4" deep x 50' long <u>coarse aggregate construction drive</u> , using 1"-3" stone with <u>fabric underlay</u> for all truck & equipment ingress/egress. <u>Daily</u> soil tracking shall be cleaned-up at days end on all paved surfaces. Have a dust abatement procedure in place.
X	2.	<u>PRIOR TO ANY EXCAVATION;</u> Leave a 10' min. strip of vegetation surrounding entire construction site. Protect all drain inlets with a <u>silt sack</u> where applicable. <u>Install silt fencing where applicable to keep soil on site and contained.</u>
X	3.	<u>DURING CONSTRUCTION</u> until final grade can be established, seed for temporary vegetative cover of rye grass, oats, beach grass or reasonable substitute on areas of bare soil.
	4.	Apply fertilizer and lime in amounts adequate for the soil type, a minimum of 1lbs of fertilizer per 200-sq. ft. of seeded or sodded surface.
X	5.	Sod or seed and mulch (10# straw per 100 square feet) all areas as soon as possible after final grade is established. (Not more than 5 days)
X	6.	<u>Provide and maintain any structures, rip-rap, or other permanent means to control possible future erosion of soil from the site.</u>
X	7.	Divert any run-off water into areas where the sediment will settle out before it leaves the site.
X	8.	<u>Avoid unnecessary removal of existing vegetative soil cover</u>

PERMIT CONDITIONS: THIS PERMIT MUST BE POSTED AND VISABLE AT THE PROJECT SITE

1. This permit does not waive the necessity for obtaining all other required federal, state, or local permits.
2. The permitted activity shall be completed in accordance with the approved plans and specifications, and the above general and specific conditions.
3. Permittee shall notify the permitting agency within one week after completing the permitted activity or one week prior to the permit expiration date, whichever ever comes first.
4. Periodic inspections will be performed with the issuance of this permit at reasonable hours.
5. The commencement of work under this permit shall constitute an acceptance by Permittee/Owner of the terms and conditions set forth in this Permit.
