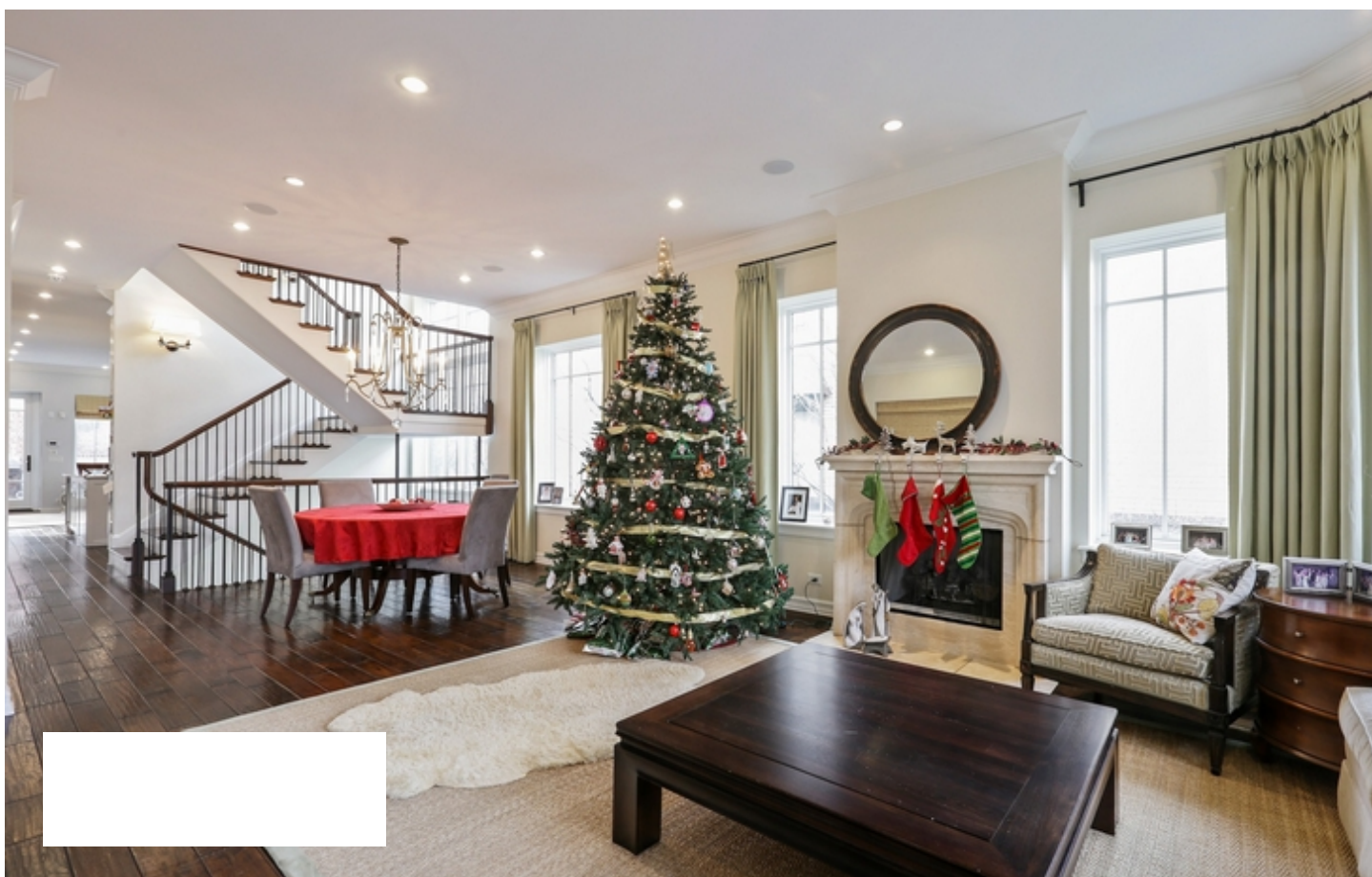

BEFORE IT HITS THE MARKET**Light in Lakeview**

The run of windows along one side of this Lakeview house are testament to a decision that a pair of homeowners and their architect made a dozen years ago. They had an extra-wide lot on Wolfram Street to work with after buying a pair of obsolete older homes that shared the site, but they opted not to fill the two lots' breadth. Instead, the house fills one side of the site, and on the other is nearly a full city lot of outdoor space. That made possible a side full of windows, including a multistory wall of glass beside the staircase, that keeps the interior of the home bright, and in touch with its outdoor counterpart. Outdoor space is abundant here. Along with the yard are multiple levels of deck and a balcony. Eleven years after moving in, homeowners Charlie and Lacesa Corry plan to put the home up for sale with SVN Auction Works, a Chicago-based firm that operates online auctions. The opening bid is \$2.45 million, and the sellers have an unpublished reserve, according to the firm's president, Diana Peterson.
